Beginning at the center of a bridge over a branch crossing the Cedar Falls Road and running thence almost with branch as line N. 58-33 E. 1127.3 feet to the center of Reedy River; thence down the center of said river to a sycamore on the west bank of said river, near the mouth of a branch; thence S. 55-03 W. 1933.8 feet to a stone; thence N. 36-31 W. 1059 feet to a stone; thence N. 61-0 E. 1022.4 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 11-34 E. 590.6 feet to the point of beginning.
