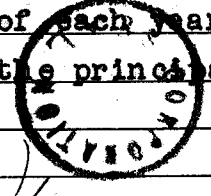

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I the said T. J. Seyle

in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to ~~SOUTHEASTERN~~ LIBERTY LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina, in the full and just sum of Sixty Two Hundred Fifty and no/100 (\$ 6250.00 ) DOLLARS, to be paid at its principal office in Greenville, S. C.

as follows: The sum of \$325.00 to be paid on the principal on the 12th day of June, 1945 and the sum of \$325.00 on the 12th day of December and June of each year thereafter up to and including the 12th day of June, 1954 and the balance of the principal shall be paid on the 12th day of December, 1954.



with interest thereon from date at the rate of four (4%) per cent, per annum, to be computed and paid semi annually on the 12 day of June and December in each year until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder thereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity, it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of its interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.
