.....in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mary A. Johnson

all that tract or lot of land in Fairview Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 122.62 acres, more or less, being designated as Tract #2 in the division of a 370 acre tract formerly known as the Chapman place and owned by S. E. Harrison and others, see judgement roll no. 3753 in the office of Clerk of Court for Greenville County, the tract hereby conveyed having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at a point on the Georgia Road at the corner of Tract #1 and thence running along the joint line with that tract S 29 E 61.20 chains to an iron pin corner of Anderson property; thence S 42 1/4 W 18.10 chains to stump; thence along line of tract #3, N 32 W 65 chains to stump on Georgia Road; thence along said road N 21 E 500 chains to stump at bend in road, N 64 1/2 E 16.53 chains to the beginning.

This is parcel No. 5 of the land conveyed to Maria Harrison by Fannie C. Scott, Probate Judge, on February 9, 1929 by deed recorded in Vol. 147 at page 326, and is the same purchased by T. C. Holland on December 18, 1944 by deed to be recorded.
