All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, on the East side of Wilton Street and being known and designated as Lot No. 26 of the Kohn property as shown by plat recorded in Plat Book E, page 212, and being more particularly described according to Survey and Plat of Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, dated January 18, 1945, as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the East side of said Street, at the Southeast corner of a 10-foot alley; thence with said alley S. 76 E. 186 feet to a stake on a 14-foot alley; thence with said alley S. 14 W. 60 feet to a stake on line of Lot No. 27; thence with line of said lot N. 76 W. 186 feet to a stake on said Street; thence with said Street N. 14 E. 60 feet to the beginning.
