All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the City of Greenville on the North side of Oak Street, being known and designated as Lot No. 5 on plat of property of Woodville Heights, recorded in Flat Book K, page 272, R. M. C. office for Greenville County, and having according to said plat and a survey thereof by Pickell & Pickell, Engrs. April 4, 1945, the following metes, bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Oak Street at corner of Lot No. 6, which point is 275.2 feet in a westerly direction from the intersection of Oak Street with Alice Street, and running thence with said Oak Street, S. 73-10 W. 60 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 4; thence N. 16-50 W. 175 feet to iron pin; thence N. 73-10 E. 60 feet to iron pin, corner of Lot No. 6; thence with the line of that lot S. 16-50 E. 175 feet to the beginning corner.
