at the southwest corner of the intersection of Whitehall street and Woodside Circle, and running thence along the line of Whitehall street in a southerly direction 85 feet, more or less, to an iron pin, corner of lot formerly belonging to J. Gantt, which point is 150 feet north at the joint Stone-Woodside line; thence along the line of the Gantt lot, in a westerly direction, 110 feet, more or less, to an iron pin in line of lot now or formerly belonging to E.
