SEND GREETINGS:

Whereas, I the said George L. Langley  
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am  
well and truly indebted to C. O. Berry

in the full and just sum of Fifteen Hundred and No/100  
(\$ 1500.00) Dollars, to be paid June 11th 1946

with interest thereon from date at the rate of six per centum per annum, to be computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

C. O. Berry, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing of the payment thereof to the said C. O. Berry

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to

the said George L. Langley  
in hand well and truly paid by the said C. O. Berry

at and before signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

C. O. Berry, All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Chick Springs Township, lying on the eastern side of the Greer-Brushy Creek Road (upper route) and being bounded on the North and West by the said road, on the East by lands now or formerly of Claude Cannon and on the south by lands of Erb Hightower and being the same tract of land conveyed to me this day by deed from C. O. Berry, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:-

Beginning on a stooping Poplar, joint corner of the Cannon and Hightower tracts and this tract, and runs thence with the Hightower line S. 62-45 W. 1020 feet to an iron pin, Hightower corner; thence N. 69-25 W. 357 feet to a point in the center of the Greer-Brushy Creek Road, Hightower's corner; thence with the center of the said road N. 38-30 E. 994 feet to an angle; thence N. 41-16 E. 100 feet to an angle; thence N. 45-47 E. 100 feet to an angle; thence N. 52-35 E. 119 feet to a nail and stopper in the center of the said road and being the corner of the former S. J. Morgan tract; thence continuing with the center of the said road N. 58-45 E. 139.5 feet to an angle; thence N. 66-20 E. 100 feet to an angle; thence N. 69-35 E. 100 feet to an angle; thence N. 71-20 E. 600 feet to a nail and stopper in the center of the said Road (iron pin on the next line on the southern bank of the said road; thence with the original line between this tract and the Cannon tract S. 26-00 W. 1101 feet to the beginning corner and containing Twenty Two and Eighty Seven One-hundredths (22.87) Acres, more or less.
