BEGINNING at a stake on the Southwest side of John Street on the corner of Lot No. 5 on said plat, approximately 198 feet from the corner of Hudson Street and running thence along said John Street N. 48 degrees 53' W. 66 feet to stake on line of lot belonging to Mrs. Gridley; thence along her line S. 41 degrees 11' W. 168.7 feet to stake on line of lot belonging to the Estate of G. W. Taylor, deceased; thence along the Taylor line S. 48 degrees 45' E. 66 feet to a stake on the West corner of Lot No. 5 on said plat; thence with line of last mentioned lot N. 41 degrees 11' E. 168.8 feet to the beginning corner.
