

Parcel II

All that tract of land lying in the city and county of Sumter, South Carolina, described as follows:

All that lot of land fronting forty (40) feet on Harvin Street and having a depth of two hundred twenty-two (222) feet, be said measurements a little more or less, said lot being bounded on the North by land formerly of the Sumter Telephone Company, on the East by lands said to be of Eugene M. Moses, on the South by land formerly of D. M. Blanding, and on the West by Harvin Street, being the same land that was conveyed by Sarah F. Brunson to R. S. Beckham by deed dated January 12, 1912, and recorded January 19, 1912, in Book G-4 at page 302 of the records in the office of the Clerk of Court of Sumter County, South Carolina.

Subdivision 3

All deposits and working funds, accounts receivable, prepaid expenses, customers' deposits, advance billings, contracts, claims, accounts, demands, choses in action, books of account, rights, privileges, franchises, licenses, easements and permits belonging to said South Carolina Continental Telephone Company and applicable to the property described in Subdivisions 1 and 2 hereof and not expressly excepted from the provisions thereof; materials and supplies useful in connection with the said Sumter Exchange, to a value of approximately \$15,000.

The execution and delivery of this instrument has been duly provided for by the Supplemental Indenture dated June 25, 1945, to said Indenture of Mortgage, and by the consent of the holders of all bonds outstanding under said Indenture of Mortgage and said Supplemental Indentures.

Nothing in this instrument contained shall be construed as in any way affecting the lien of said Indenture of Mortgage and said Supplemental Indentures with respect to any of the property covered or conveyed thereby, excepting the property hereinabove specifically described and by this instrument specifically released from the lien thereof.
