NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That the said Mortgagor, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Mortgagee, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to the said Mortgagor, in hand well and truly paid by the said Mortgagee, at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain and release unto the said Mortgagee, and its successors Heirs and Assigns, forever, all and singular that certain piece, parcel, lot or tract of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State aforesaid, In Greenville

Township, on the southern side of Pendleton Street in the City of Greenville, being shown as Lot No. 1 on plat of property of Nellie H. Mackey made by R. E. Dalton in December, 1921, recorded in Plat Book F at page 20 and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the southern side of Pendleton Street 106.6 feet east from Sumner Street, at corner of Lot No. 2 and running thence with line of said Lot S. 20-20 W. 172.2 feet to a stake in line of Lot No. 4; thence with the line of said Lot S. 70-27 E. 102.7 feet to a stake on line of property now or formerly owned by Ella W. Ward; thence with line of said Lot N. 19-23 E. 172.7 feet to a stake on Pendleton Street; thence with the southern side of Pendleton Street N. 70-48 W. 100 feet to the beginning corner.
