Williams line; thence with Williams line to S. A. Barton's line; thence with Barton's line to a stone (formerly a Chestnut, the corner between C. G. Drake and S. A. Barton and J. M. Cantrell line to land sold by C. G. Drake to W. H. Patterson; thence with that line to a white oak, now gone, near a spring cemented around, known as Reynolds Spring; thence S. 67 2/3 E. 7.00 to a stone; thence N. 33 1/4 E. 200 to a walnut across the river on the North side of the river; thence S. 53 W. 5.50 to a stone in line of lot sold to M.
