

MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, S. B. Wasson, Jr., of Greenville, S. C., SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS I, the said S. B. Wasson

in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am well and truly indebted to
FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, in the full and just sum of TWO THOUSAND, SIX HUNDRED AND

NO/100 Dollars, with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of TWENTY-TWO AND NO/100
(\$ 2,600.00) Dollars, with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of (\$ 22.00) Dollars upon the first

day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said S. B. Wasson, Jr.,

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me

the said S. B. Wasson, Jr., in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., the following described property to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Butler Township, on the east side of Lindsay avenue, about 2 1/2 miles southeast of the Greenville County Courthouse, and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 81 and 82 of a subdivision known as East Lynne as shown on plat thereof made by Dalton & Neves, Engrs., in June 1931, and recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book H, at page 195, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeast side of Lindsay avenue at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 80 and 81, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 80, S. 55-45 E. 205 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 35-06 W. 50 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 82 and 83; thence along the line of Lot No. 83, N. 55-45 W. 205 feet to an iron pin on the southeast side of Lindsay avenue; thence along the southeast side of Lindsay avenue, N. 35-06 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot in which E. Inman, Master, conveyed me the undivided one-half interest of Ida A. Wasson by deed not yet recorded, and is the same lot conveyed to me and Ida A. Wasson by Jannette C. Harris by deed Sept. 6, 1945 and recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 280, page 113."
