TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

We, Whit W. Klugh and Clayton S. Klugh SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS We the said Whit W. Klugh and Clayton S. Klugh

in and by our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents are well and truly indebted to

FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, in the full and just sum of FIVE THOUSAND, FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100

(\$ 5,500.00) Dollars, with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of FIFTY AND NO/100

(\$ 50.00) Dollars upon the first

day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That We the said Whit W. Klugh and Clayton S. Klugh

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to us

in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. "All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Ward Two of the City of Greenville, on the east side of East North Street, being known and designated as Lot No. 1 of the property of George Norwood subdivision as shown on plat thereof made by W. M. Rast, Engr., in May, 1929, and recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book H, at page 277, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the east side of East North Street Extension at the corner of Lot No. 9 of the Overbrook property, and running thence along the joint line of Lot No. 9 of the Overbrook property and Lot No. 1, of the Norwood property, S. 48-56 E. 200 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of said lots; thence S. 41-04 W. 45.9 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2 of the Norwood property; (now or formerly belonging to Maude P. King); thence along a new line of lot conveyed by Thomas B. Williams to Maude P. King, N. 49-24 W. 162.1 feet to an iron pin at a point 2 feet northeast of the Northeast corner of the residence of Maude P. King; thence N. 53-07 W. 38 feet to an iron pin on the east side of East North street, which point is 4 feet northeast of the joint corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2; thence along the east side of East North street, N. 41-02 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot conveyed to us by Cora E. Mason by deed of even date herewith, not yet recorded."
