Be it known: That Piedmont Consistory .32 Degree Masons of the Southern Jurisdiction Scottish Rite Masons of the United States, in regular legal meeting at Chappelle's Hall, Greenville, S. C. on October 22, 1945, did by full unanimous vote, appoint the following Committee of Trustees: William D. Addison, Chairman; William Gantt, F. G. Washington, W.A. Berry, R. E. Lipscomb, A. M. Moore and L. W. Wright, with full powers and authority to act and do business with Mr. ^{J.P.}Chappelle to purchase the property known as Chappelle Hall located in Greenville, City and County, State of South Carolina.

Further said Committee of Trustees have full powers to bargain and buy said building in the Name of Piedmont Consistory #169, Scottish Rite, Southern Jurisdiction U.S.A. and to pay over to Mr. J. P. Chappelle the already agreed (\$500.00) Five Hundred -- and --No/100 Dollars as down payment and the remainder of the purchase price (\$5000.00) Five Thousand and --No/100 Dollars at the rate of (\$400.00) Four Hundred -- and -- No/100 Dollars on the principal along with interest at the rate of three per cent per annum until full balance is paid,

Further: That said Committee is to receive a good and sufficient Deed to said Chappelle Hall, and to give unto Mr. J. P. Chappelle a good and sufficient Mortgage for the balance of (4500) Four Thousand, Five Hundred - and No/100-- Dollars in the name of Piedmont Consistory, said Committee acting as Trustees for Piedmont Consistory.

Further: Committee is empowered to transact whatever other business with Mr. Chappelle in the buying of Chappelle Hall for Piedmont Consistory
