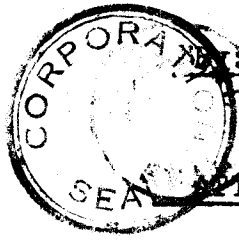

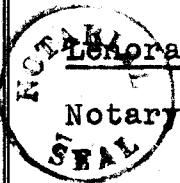

For and in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Easley Bank, Easley, S. C., the owner and holder of a note and mortgage executed by T. B. Nalley to Easley Bank, Easley, S. C. in the amount of \$4,000.00 dated June 27, 1945, and recorded in Book of Mortgages 335 at page 221, in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, South Carolina, does hereby release and forever relinquish from the lien of said mortgage the following described lands:

"ALL that piece, parcel or tract of land in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Chick Springs Township, and lying on the North side of the Buck Horn Road, and being bounded on the North and East by other lands of T. B. Nalley, on the South by the Buck Horn Road, and on the West by a new road leading from the Buck Horn Road to the road leading to Travelers Rest, and containing Ten(10) acres according to plat of J. Coke Smith, Surveyor, dated December 1, 1945, and having the following courses and distances according to said plat: BEGINNING at an Iron Pin on the corner of the property of T. B. Nalley, at the Northeast corner of the tract, and running thence South 7-00 East 10.00 chains to point on Buck Horn Road; thence running along the said Buck Horn Road North 89-50 West 11.00 chains to point in the Buck Horn road; thence leaving the road North 3-00 East 5.27 chains; thence North 5-15 West 4.73 chains to point in a new road; thence leaving new road North 89-15 East 9.00 chains to Iron Pin, the BEGINNING corner, and being a portion of the lands conveyed to T. B. Nalley by Mrs. S. A. Boling by deed dated June 27, 1945, and recorded in Book of Deeds 277 at page 142, in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, South Carolina."

Said mortgage shall in all other respects remain of full force and effect.
