TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

We, Charles E. Collisn and Montez M. Collins SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS we the said Charles E. Collins and Montez M. Collins

in and by our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents are well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, in the full and just sum of SEVEN THOUSAND, EIGHT HUNDRED AND NO/100

(\$ 7,800.00) Dollars, with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of SEVENTY-FIVE AND NO/100 (\$ 75.00) Dollars upon the first

day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest, has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney fee besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all which is secured under this mortgage); and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That we the said Charles E. Collins and Montez M. Collins

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$ 3.00) us the said Charles E. Collins and Montez M. Collins

in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., the following described property to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township, on the north side of Colonial Avenue, and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 17 and 18, of Block V, of a subdivision known as Riverside as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book A, at page 323, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the north side of Colonial avenue at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 18 and 19, of Block V, which point is 100 feet west of the northwest corner of the intersection of Colonial Avenue and Green Street, and running thence along the north side of Colonial Avenue, N. 79-57 W. 100 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 16 and 17, of Block V; thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 10-15 E. 125 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of said lots on a 15-foot alley; thence along the south side of said alley, S. 79-57 E. 100 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 18 and 19; thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 10-15 W. 125 feet to the beginning corner. Lot No. 17, Block V, was conveyed to us by Allen Cathcart et al., by deed dated Aug. 20, 1942 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 247, page 83; and Lot No. 18 of Block V, was conveyed to us by L. J. Prince by deed dated May 5th, 1943 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 253, page 293." Also:-

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township, School District B-F, and being known and designated as Lot No. 4, of Block B, of a subdivision known as Woodville Heights as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book K, at page 272 (formerly Plat Book L, pages 14 and 15), and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin at the southwest corner of the intersection of Oak Street and Wood Street, and running thence along the west side of Wood Street, S. 9-00 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 73-10 W. 65.7 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 5; thence along the line of that lot, N. 9-00 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the south side of Oak street; thence along the south side of Oak Street, N. 73-10 E. 65.7 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot conveyed to Mrs. C. E. Collins by N. O. McDowell, Jr., et al., by deed dated Aug. 25, 1944 and recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 272, page 325."
