

Norris by deed dated November 12, 1935, recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 129 Page 404. The above described lot is covered by a mortgage executed by the Mortgagor herein to Liberty Life Insurance Company, dated September 14, 1943, in the principal amount of \$100,000.00 and recorded in Mortgage Vol. 321 Page 166, and by an additional mortgage executed by the Mortgagor herein to Liberty Life Insurance Company, dated September 14, 1944, in the principal sum of \$16,000.00, and recorded in Mortgage Vol. 239 Page 62.
