organized and existing under the laws of South Carolina, a corporation hereinafter called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Four Thousand & No/100ths - - - - - Dollars (\$ 4000.00), with interest from date at the rate of Four and One-Half-centum (4 1/2 %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of Liberty Life Insurance Company in Greenville, South Carolina, or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of Twenty-Two & 24/100ths Dollars (\$ 22.24), commencing on the first day of April, 19 46, and on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of March, 1971.

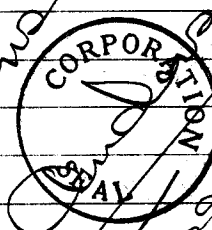
NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the Northeast side of Sitka Avenue (formerly known as King Street) in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as Lot 24 on Plat of Parkview, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, June 1942, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "M", Page 49, and having according to said Plat and a recent survey made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, March 25, 1946, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeast side of Sitka Avenue at joint front corner of Lots 23 and 24, said pin also being 25 feet in a Southeasterly direction from the point where the Northeast side of Sitka Avenue intersects with the Southeast side of Haviland Avenue and running thence with the line of Lot 23 N. 63-45 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence along the rear line of Lot 42 and 43 S. 26-15 E. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 25 S. 63-45 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the Northeast side of Sitka Avenue; thence with the Northeast side of Sitka Avenue N. 26-15 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner.
