In consideration of the sum of TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS(\$10,000), to the undersigned Reconstruction Finance Corporation in hand paid by Norris Brothers, Greenville, South Carolina, and applied on the indebtedness of Norris Brothers secured by that certain deed of trust to the South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, Columbia, South Carolina, dated December 6, 1945, and recorded in Book 341, page 1, in the Office of the Register of Mesne Conveyances of Greenville County, South Carolina, the Reconstruction Finance Corporation, acting pursuant to Execution Order 9665(11F.R.3), does hereby release to the said Norris Brothers, its successors and assigns, that certain lot of land situated on West Coffee Street in the City of Greenville, South Carolina, referred to in and conveyed by said deed of trust as "Lot No. 4", and more particularly described as follows:

"LOT NO. 4: BEGINNING at a stake on West Coffee Street 150.6 feet from South West Corner of West Coffee and Richardson Streets; thence S. 20-30 W. 105 feet to a stake on line of First Presbyterian Church; thence with said lot N. 68-45 W. 60.5 feet to a stake corner of lot now or formerly of Estate of T. F. Hunt, et al; thence with said lot N. 19-30 E. 104 feet to stake on West Coffee Street; thence with said Street S. 69-45 E. 62.5 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot of land conveyed to the mortgagor by deed of D. L. Norris, dated September 1, 1920 and recorded in said office in Vol. 127 page 599."
