all that tract or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, about four miles southeast from Greenville, on the east side of White Horse Road, near Gantt School, being shown and designated as Lot No. 4 on plat of P. L. Bruce and C. O. Berry property, prepared by S. C. Moon February 1939, having the following courses and distances:

BEGINNING on a stake on the east side of White Horse Road and being the joint corner of Lots 4 and 5, and running thence with line of Lot No. 5 S. 85-45 E. 214.5 feet to stake on line of Lot No. 7; thence with line of Lot No. 7, N. 17-18 W. 51 feet to stake, joint corner of Lots 3, 4, 7 and 65; thence with line of Lot No. 3, N. 87-25 W. 224.5 feet to point on eastern edge of the White Horse Road; thence with said road S. 31-20 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner.
