MORTGAGE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: I, C. L. Lindsay

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Thirty-Two Hundred and No/100

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, just outside the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, on the South side of Orlando Avenue, being known and designated as Lot No. 76 on a plat of "Leawood Extension", formerly known as "Paris Piney Park", plat of Leawood Extension was made by C. C. Jones, Civil Engineer, dated September 1, 1941, said plat being recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book M at Page 35, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

"BEGINNING at a point on the South side of Orlando Avenue, joint corner of Lots Nos. 75 and 76 and running thence S. 33-54 W. 150 feet; thence S. 56-06 E 50 feet to joint rear corner of Lot Nos. 76 and 77; thence N. 33-54 E. 150 feet to a point on Orlando Avenue; thence with Orlando Avenue N. 56-06 W. 50 feet to the point of beginning."
