I, W. J. Bell, of Greenville County, S. C.,

WHEREAS I, the said W. J. Bell

in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents AM well and truly indebted to  
FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, in the sum and just sum of ONE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED AND  
NO/100 four and one-half (4 1/2%)

(\$1,600.00) Dollars, with interest at the rate of 17 (17%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of SIXTEEN AND NO/100  
(\$ 16.00) Dollars upon the first

day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said W. J. Bell

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND  
LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of three Dollars to me,

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, and being known and designated as portion of Lots Nos. 4, 5

and 6, of Map 2, of a subdivision known as Woodville Heights, as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book L, at pages 14 and 15, and being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:-

"BEGINNING at an iron pin at the southwest corner of the intersection of Fourth Street and an alley, and running thence along the line of said alley S. 40-00 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the west side of said alley; thence in a westerly direction 82 feet to an iron pin; thence in a northeasterly direction 125 feet to an iron pin on the southwest side of Fourth Street; thence along the southwest side of said Fourth Street, S. 71-30 E. 140 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot conveyed to me by Lillie Mae Davidson by deed of even date herewith, not yet recorded, this mortgage being given to secure the unpaid portion of the purchase price."
