NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That the said Mortgagor, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Mortgagee, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to the said Mortgagor, in hand well and truly paid by the said Mortgagee, at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain and release unto the said Mortgagee, and its Successors and Assigns, forever, all and singular that certain piece, parcel, lot or tract of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State aforesaid, near American Spinning Company,

about two and one-half miles Northwest from the Greenville County Courthouse, on the West side of Buncombe Road, being a portion of Lot No. 206 as shown on plat of the McCary tract, which plat is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book A at Page 279, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of said Buncombe Road, at joint corner of Lots Nos. 205 and 206, and running thence along said road about N. 13-30 E. 60 feet to an iron pin, said pin being exactly 6 feet from the corner of Lot No. 207; thence in a Northwesterly direction and parallel with line of Lot No. 207, 204 feet to an iron pin in line of Lot No. 214; thence along line of last mentioned lot, 60 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lots Nos. 206 and 215; thence along the dividing line of Lots Nos. 205 and 206, 204 feet to the beginning corner.

Said premises being the same conveyed to the mortgagor by Letha Pearl Neely by deed dated August 21, 1928, recorded in Volume 136 at Page 334.
