

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, on the Eastern side of Willis Avenue, being a part of Lot No.30,

as shown on plat of property of H. H. Willis made by W. J. Riddle, in November 1939, recorded in Plat Book J at Page 150, and described as follows:

"BECINNING at a stake on the Eastern side of Willis Avenue at corner of Lot No. 31, and running thence with the line of said lot, S. 80-30 E. 383 feet to a stake, corner of Lot No. 16; thence with the line of said lot, S. 36-15 W. 100 feet to a stake at corner of Lot No. 17; thence in a Westerly direction 190 feet to a stake; thence in a Southerly direction 100 feet to a stake on Willis on line of Lot No. 29; thence with the line of said lot, N. 75 W. 160 feet to a stake on Willis Avenue; thence with the Eastern side of Willis Avenue, N. 19-32 E. 100.5 feet to a stake; thence N. 6-30 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner."
