To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

We, George O. Smith, Jr. & Hellen L. Smith, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, we the said George O. Smith, Jr. & Hellen L. Smith in and by our certain promissory note in writing of even date with these Presents, are well and truly indebted unto the CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S. C., in the full and just sum of One Thousand & 00/100 (\$ 1000.00) Dollars, with interest from the date hereof at the rate of seven (7%) per cent per annum, unpaid interest to bear interest at the same rate, to be repaid in installments of Sixteen & 00/100 (\$ 16.00) dollars

due and payable on the 5th day of each and every calendar month hereafter until the full principal sum, with interest and all costs, insurance, and expenses incurred in connection with said loan, has been paid, said monthly payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, and then to payment of principal, costs, expenses and insurance, and incurred; and said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due hereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of sixty (60) days, or upon failure to comply with any of the by-laws of said Association, or with any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall be the option of the holder become immediately due and payable, and said note further providing for a reasonable attorney's fee besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed with an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we the said George O. Smith, Jr. and Hellen L. Smith, in consideration of the said debt and sums of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said CITIZENS BUILDING & LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S. C., according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to us the said mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee, it and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents (receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S. C., its successors and assigns:

That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, in the City of Greer, lying between Cannon Avenue and Westfield Street (formerly Maud Street), on the east side of South Main Street, being all of lots #'s 1 and 26 on a plat or plats of the M. T. Gaines property, having the following courses and distances:

BEGINNING on a stake at the corner of Cannon Avenue and South Main Street, and runs thence with the north side of Cannon Avenue S. 82.15 E. 150 feet to a stake; thence N. 1.00 E 179.9 feet to a stake on the south side of Westfield Street (formerly Maud Street); thence with the south side of Westfield Street S. 77.15 W. 144.6 feet to a stake, corner of Westfield Street and South Main Street; thence with the east side of South Main Street S. 2.30 W. 120 feet to the beginning corner. See plat on record in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book D, at pages 260 to 263, inclusive, this being the same property conveyed to us by Marshall O. Pennington by deed dated November 10, 1945, and recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 283, page 17.
