WHEREAS, I, Mary E. Page

in and by me certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents all well and truly indebted to The Peoples National Bank, Greenville, South Carolina, in the full and just sum of One Thousand and No/100 (\$1,000.00) Dollars to be paid: in quarterly installments of \$75.00 each on the 22nd day of each third month hereafter; said payments to be applied first to interest and then to principal until paid in full

with interest thereon from date at the rate of six (6%) per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid quarterly until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten (10%) per cent. of the amount due thereon, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That the said Mortgagor, I, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Mortgagee, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to the said Mortgagor, in hand well and truly paid by the said Mortgagee, at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain and release unto the said Mortgagee, and his Heirs and Assigns, forever, all and singular that certain piece, parcel, lot or tract of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township Greenville County, State aforesaid, on the Southwestern corner of

Washington Avenue (formerly Old White Horse Road) and Gordon Street, being a portion of Lots Nos. 17, 18 and 19 as shown on a proposed re-subdivision of the Old Looper Yew Property, recorded in Plat Book F at Page 48, and also being shown as Lot No. 1, Block 5, Page 230 of the County Block Book, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake at the Southwestern corner of Gordon Street and Washington Avenue, and running thence with the Southern side of Gordon Street, S. 79-20 W. 340 feet, more or less, to stake on Link Street; thence with the Eastern side of Link Street, S. 21-30 E. 150 feet, more or less, to a stake; thence in an easterly direction 335 feet, more or less, to a stake on Washington Avenue; thence with the Western side of Washington Avenue, N. 21-30 W. 100 feet to the beginning corner.
