MORTGAGE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:----- I, Mary B. Cooper  
----- (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Twenty-five Hundred and No/100 - - - - - DOLLARS (\$2,500.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of five (5%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Greenville Township, known as a part of Lot No. 5 of Section B of Plat recorded in Plat Book A at Pages 337-345 (Plat of Stone Land Company), in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and more particularly described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a point on the West side of Whitehall Street, 135 feet from the Southwest corner of Randall and Whitehall Streets; thence S. 1-41 W. 65 feet to corner of Whitehall Street and alley at rear of lot No. 5; thence along said alley 70 feet to joint rear corners of Lots Nos. 3 and 5 of Section B; thence N. 1-41 E. 65 feet along the western line of said Lot No. 5; thence S. 85-39 E. 70 feet to the point of beginning."

Said premises being the same conveyed to the mortgagor by J. H. Cooper by deed dated July 5, 1940, recorded in Book of Deeds 223 at Page 377.
