MORTGAGE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: I, Ira S. Campbell
.....(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Nineteen Hundred and No/100 DOLLARS (\$1,900.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may heréafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the West side of Charleston Street near the City of Greenville, known and designated as Lot No. 51 on plat of Victor-Monaghan Company Development No. 1, made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, December, 1941, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book M at Page 39, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northwestern side of Charleston Street at joint front corner of Lots Nos. 50 and 51, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 50, N. 49-10 W. 289.6 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 74-00 E. 149.5 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 52; thence with the line of Lot No. 52, S. 49-10 E. 198 feet to an iron pin on the Northwestern side of Charleston Street; thence with the Northwestern side of Charleston Street, S. 40-50 W. 125 feet to the beginning corner."

Said premises being the same conveyed to the mortgagor by Victor-Monaghan Company by deed dated April 17, 1944, recorded in Volume 263 at Page 62.
