MORTGAGE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: I, D. U. Mauldin

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Thirty-Six Hundred & No/100 DOLLARS (\$3,600.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of five & one-half per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 11, of a subdivision known as Franklin Heights, as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book L at Page 9, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Franklin Road at the corner of Lot No. 12, which point is 83.5 feet east of the Northeast corner of the intersection of Circle Drive and Franklin Road, and running thence along the line of Lot No. 12, N. 28-30 E. 138.6 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of said Lot No. 12; thence along the rear line of Lot No. 14, S. 72-23 E. 65 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 10; thence along the line of Lot No. 10, S. 20-0 W. 140 feet to an iron pin on the North side of Franklin Road; thence along the North side of Franklin Road, N. 70-0 W. 85 feet to the beginning corner."
