MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

We, James M. Harris, Jr., and Jo Alice P. Harris, of Greenville, South Carolina

WHEREAS, we the said James M. Harris, Jr., and Jo Alice P. Harris, SEND GREETING:

in and by our certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents are well and truly indebted to Canal Insurance Company in the full and just sum of Forty-two Hundred Fifty & No/100 (\$ 4,250.00) DOLLARS, to be paid at Canal Ins. Co. Office in Greenville, S. C., together with interest thereon from date September 1, 1946 until maturity at the rate of four (4%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest being payable in monthly installments as follows:

Beginning on the 1st day of October, 19 46, and on the 1st day of each month of each year thereafter the sum of \$ 25.76, to be applied on the interest and principal of said note, said payments to continue up to and including the 1st day of September, 19 66, and the balance of said principal and interest to be due and payable on the 1st day of September, 19 66; the aforesaid monthly payments of \$ 25.76 each are to be applied first to interest at the rate of four (4%) per centum per annum on the principal sum of \$ 4250.00 or so much thereof as shall from time to time, remain unpaid and the balance of each monthly payment shall be applied on account of principal.

All installments of principal and all interest are payable in lawful money of the United States of America; and in the event default is made in the payment of any installment or installments, or any part hereof, as therein provided, the same shall bear simple interest from the date of such default until paid at the rate of four (4) per centum per annum.

And if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, or if default be made in respect to any condition, agreement or covenant contained herein, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder thereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity, it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of its interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including (10%) per cent, of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That we, the said James M. Harris, Jr. and Jo Alice P. Harris in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Canal Insurance Company according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of THREE DOLLARS, to us the said JAMES M. Harris, Jr. and Jo Alice P. Harris in hand and truly paid by the said Canal Insurance Company at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt thereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Canal Insurance Company, its successors and assigns:

All that certain lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, South Carolina, just outside the city limits of the City of Greenville on the South side of Mills Avenue, being known and designated as lot No. 39 on plat of Jane G. Hammond property known as Langley Heights, made by Dalton & Neves, June 1937, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for said Greenville County in Plat Book "N", Page 133, and having according to the said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

BEGINNING at a point on the South side of said Mills Avenue, 252.6 feet from the intersection of Mills Avenue and Edgewood Drive, and running thence with the said Mills Avenue N. 39-17 E. 50 feet to a point of said Mills Avenue, joint corner of lots Nos. 38 and 39; thence with the joint line of said lots Nos. 38 and 39, S. 50-43 E. 175.6 feet to a point on a 15 foot alley, joint rear corner of said lots Nos. 38 and 39; thence along the line of said 15 foot alley, S. 46-47 W. 50.43 feet to a point, joint rear corner of lots Nos. 39 and 40; thence along the joint line of said lots Nos. 39 and 40, N. 50-43 W. 169 feet to the point of beginning, joint corner of lots Nos. 39 and 40 on Mills Avenue.

THE MORTGAGOR COVENANTS AND AGREES that with the monthly payments of principal and interest he will pay to mortgagee a pro rata portion of the taxes, assessments, and insurance premiums next to become due, as estimated by the mortgagee, so that mortgagee will have sufficient funds on hand to pay taxes, assessments, and insurance premiums thirty days before the delinquency date thereof. Any deficit shall immediately be paid to the mortgagee by mortgagor. Moneys so held shall not bear interest, and upon default may be applied by mortgagee on account of the mortgage indebtedness.
