MORTGAGE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN, William R. Sanders  
.....(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Six Thousand and No/100 DOLLARS (\$6,000.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of four (4%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, on Blue Ridge Drive between Newland Avenue and the Perry Road in that section known as Sans Souci, about two miles North of the City of Greenville, said lot having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southern edge of a 5-foot side-walk running along Blue Ridge Drive, said pin being the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 31 and 32, and running thence along the Western line of Lot No. 31, S. 5-50 E. 152.7 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of said Lots Nos. 31 and 32; thence along the rear line of Lot No. 57, S. 82-45 W. 60 feet to an iron pin, rear joint corner of Lots Nos. 32 and 33; thence along the Eastern line of Lot No. 33, N. 5-50 W. 158 feet to an iron pin, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 32 and 33; thence along the Southern edge of said sidewalk running along Blue Ridge Drive, N. 87-37 E. 60 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner; said lot being known and designated as Lot No. 32 on plat of said property recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "0", at Page 45, which plat is hereby referred to and made a part hereof."

Said premises being the same conveyed to the mortgagor by A. A. Broadnax and Sarah I. Broadnax by deed dated October 3, 1946, recorded in Volume 300 at Page 107.
