All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Austin Township, County and State aforesaid, located on the Greenville-Woodruff Road near Five Forks bounded by lands of said T. B. Waters, D. B. Verdin and others, having metes and bounds as follows: Beginning at a point in the Greenville-Woodruff Road and running thence with Waters' line S. 68-20 W. 652 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 29 E. 670 feet to a stake; thence by a new line N. 59-30 E. 852 feet to a point in road named above; thence along said road N. 51-25 W. 235.5 feet to a bend; thence N. 49 W. 362 feet to the beginning corner, containing 10.66 acres, more or less, according to survey made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, on January 30th, 1929.

This is the same land conveyed to me by Thomas B. Waters and Norman McKinley Waters otherwise known as Norman Paul Waters and this obligation is made to secure funds with which to pay a balance due on the purchase price.
