Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "A" at Page 97, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

BEGINNING at a stake on corner of Traction Street and Bennett Street, and running thence with Bennett Street, N. 45-45 E. 142 feet; thence with the line of Lot No. 1, N. 46-15 W. 50 feet; thence with the line of Lot No. 15, S. 43-45 W. 146 feet to Traction Street; thence with Traction Street in an Easterly direction, approximately 50 feet to the beginning corner.
