

## TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

Whereas on the 24th day of January 1947 the undersigned Charles S. Rigby, 118 Manley Street, Greenville, South Carolina, executed to The Peoples National Bank of Greenville, South Carolina, a note and mortgage dated January 24, 1947 in the sum of nine thousand dollars and according to the terms of said note and mortgage, which mortgage is of record in the R. Office for Greenville County in Real Estate Book Volume 358, page 49, the same is payable as follows: two hundred dollars on the 24th day of April 1947 and two hundred dollars on the 24th day of each July, October, January and April of each year thereafter until the entire principal sum is paid in full, when in reality it was the understanding and intention of the undersigned and The Peoples National Bank of Greenville, South Carolina that the balance due upon the principal of said indebtedness would become due and payable on the 24th day of January 1957, and the undersigned does hereby acknowledge that the balance of the indebtedness represented by said note and mortgage above referred to shall become due and payable on the 24th day of January 1957 unless said indebtedness shall have in the meanwhile been paid in full, and does hereby agree and consent that the terms of said note and mortgage as written shall be so amended.
