with interest thereon from date at the rate of 4 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All of that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in said State and County, Chick Springs Township, near Pleasant Grove Baptist Church, about two miles South from Greer, containing Twenty-eight(28) acres, more or less, bounded by lands of Arthur Millinax, John Rogers and the Mattox home place, having courses and distances according to plat thereof by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated December 13th 1933, as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of the intersection of the old Greenville-Spartanburg road and the Buncombe road and running thence in a southeast direction along the Buncombe Road as a line to an iron pin on Roger's line; thence along Roger's line N. 13-45 E. 30.48 chs. to an iron pin the old Greenville-Spartanburg road; thence along said road S. 58-15 W. 6.31 chains to iron pin, angle in road; thence along same S. 55.00 W. 20.12 chs. to the beginning corner, this being all of the same lot of land conveyed to me by J.
