with interest from date at the rate of four per centum (4%) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of Carolina Housing and Mortgage Corporation

in Hickory, North Carolina or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing delivered or mailed to the

Mortgagor, in monthly installments of Forty-Six and 06/100 Dollars (46.06),

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, lying and being situate on the South side of Beck Avenue, Augusta Road Ranches, being known and designated as Lot #249, Augusta Road Ranches, near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, South Carolina, according to Plat of said sub-division prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, in April, 1941, as revised in April 1942, as recorded in the R.M.C.
