L. Bates, his heirs and assigns,

all that tract or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, at the southeast intersection of the Laurens Road and Parkins Mill Road (now Dakota Avenue), near the City of Greenville, fronting 210 feet on the Laurens Road, and extending back a depth of 210 feet along the Parkins Mill Road, containing one(1) acre, more or less, howneve, a strip conveyed off the front of said lot to the South Carolina Highway Department for the purpose of widening the Laurens Road, and being designated on the County Block Book as Lot No. 1, Block 13, Page 265. There is situate on this lot a brick store building and a residence.

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
