

MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

AND it is further covenanted and agreed by said parties that in default of the payment by said Mortgagor of all or any taxes, charges and assessments which may be imposed by law upon the said mortgaged premises...

AND the said Mortgagor further covenants and agrees, should the said obligation be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, by suit or otherwise, in case of any default in the covenants and agreements herein contained...
