Stone Avenue, and having according to a survey and plat thereof made by R.E. Dalton, Engineer November 6, 1924, the following courses and distances, to-wit:-

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of East Stone Avenue, 110 ft. from the North-eastern intersection of North Main Street and Stone Avenue and running thence N. 12-12 E. 132 ft. to a stake: thence S. 72 E. 52 ft. 8 in. to a stake in the line of the lot now or formerly owned by A. Katz: thence along said line S. 17-34 W. 132 ft. to a brick wall in Stone Avenue; thence along said Stone Avenue N. 72-00 W. 54 ft. 4 in to the point of beginning.
