All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 8 of a subdivision known as Avice-Dale about four (4) miles West of Greenville near the Old Easley Bridge Road. The plat of same being recorded in the Office of R.M.C. for Greenville County in Plat Book "B" at page 53 and being more fully described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeast side of Avice-Dale Drive at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 8 and 9 and running thence along Avice-Dale Drive S. 22-55 W. 350 feet to an iron pin at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 7 and 8; thence along the joint line of said lot S. 55 E. 535 feet to the rear joint corner of lots Nos. 7 and 8, thence N. 30-37 E. 379 feet to the rear joint corner of Lots Nos. 8 and 9; thence along joint line of Lots Nos. 8 and 9; N.58-30 W. 580 feet to the beginning corner, and containing 4.59 acres, more or less.
