I, LAWRENCE REID

SEND GREETINGS:

Whereas, I the said Lawrence Reid

in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to Mildred E. Long

in the full and just sum of Two Thousand Five Hundred (\$2,500.00) Dollars
Dollars, to be paid five months from date

with interest thereon from date at the rate of five (5%) per centum per annum, to be computed and paid at maturity

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Mildred E. Long, her heirs and assigns, forever:-

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, situate, lying and being on the South side of Woodville Avenue, in that subdivision known as Overbrook, and being known and designated as the Eastern one-half of Lot No. 113, as shown on plat No. 3 of property of Overbrook Land Company and Woodville Investment Company, prepared by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, January 1924, and recorded in the Office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County in Plat Book "F" at page 218, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

BEGINNING at a stake on the South side of Woodville Avenue, the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 113 and 114; thence along the South side of Woodville Avenue, N. 66-00 W. 60 feet to a point in the middle of the front line of said Lot No. 113; thence in a straight line through the middle of Lot No. 113 approximately S. 26-35 W. 104.7 feet, more or less, to a point, which point is in the middle of the rear line of Lot #113; thence along the joint rear line of Lot No. 113 and Lot No. 105 and No. 104; S. 70-43 E. 64.3 feet to an iron pin, the Southwest corner of Lot No. 114; thence along the dividing line of Lots Nos. 113 and 114, N. 24-27 E. 99.3 feet to the point of beginning.
