to be paid: in monthly installments of Thirty and No/100 (\$30.00) Dollars each on the 13th day of each month hereafter, beginning November 13th, 1947, said payments to be applied first to interest and then to principal until paid in full.

with interest thereon from semi-annually date monthly at the rate of six (6%)
