TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: I, Johnny Quinn

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Twenty-Five Hundred and No/100 -----

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, on the Eastern side of Earle Drive, about four miles West of the City of Greenville being shown as No. 4-D, Block 1 of Page 240 of the County Block Book, and described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a point in the center of Earle Drive at corner of lands of T. C. Quinn and W. E. Page, and running thence along their lines, S. 28-38 E. 392 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 86-27 W. 41.4 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 36-29 W. 309 feet to a point in Earle Drive; thence along said Earle Drive, N. 20-50 E. 99.9 feet to the beginning corner, and containing one-half of one acre, more or less."
