I, W.W. Jordan

SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, the said W.W. Jordan

in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these Presents, I am well and truly indebted to Bank of Piedmont

in the full and just sum of Seven Thousand Five Hundred and NO/00, to be paid Payable one year from date

, with interest thereon from date at the rate of 4 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Bank of Piedmont, its successors and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being east of the Augusta road, five miles from Greenville County Courthouse, being shown as the rear part of lot # 1 on plat of property of Julia D. Charles made by W.J. Riddle, Surveyor, September 16, 1936, containing 25.20 acres, more or less, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the southeast corner of Lot No. 2 on said plat, said pin being approximately 1101.6 feet northeast from the joint front corner of Lots Nos. land 2 on Augusta Road, and running thence across road leading from the tract of land herin described to the Augusta Road, S. 26-30 E. 40 feet, more or less, to an iron pin on southeast side of said road in line of property of H. J.
