

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of South Florida Avenue at a point in the center of the front line of Lot No. 8, of Block 0, which point is 30 feet South of the corner of Lot No. 7, and running thence along the West side of South Florida Avenue, almost due south, 90 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot No. 10, of Block 0; thence along the line of that lot, N. 89-45 W. 195 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of said lot; thence almost due North 90 feet to an iron pin in the center of the rear line of Lot No. 8, which point is 30 feet south of the rear corner of Lot No. 7; thence on a line through the center of Lot No. 8, S. 89-45 E. 195 feet to the beginning corner," and

That the aforesaid Lot No. 10, of Block 0, be and the same is hereby released, relinquished and forever discharged from the lien of the above described mortgage, and that the mortgagor shall be free to sell and dispose of said Lot No. 10 as he desires, and that the lien of the above described mortgage as recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 356, at page 295 shall continue in full force and effect on Lot No. 9, of Block 0, as described therein, and shall also be extended to include that portion of Lot No. 8, of Block 0, as purchased by the mortgagor herein from the said H. B. Nalley, to have and to hold all and singular the premises last above described unto the First Federal Savings and Loan Association of Greenville, its successors and assigns forever, and that a copy of this agreement be submitted to the Veterans Administration Loan Guaranty Officer for his approval.
