along the common line of said last mentioned lots, S. 88-0 E. 182.5 feet
to an iron pin in the center of a 5 foot strip reserved for utilities;
thence along the center of said strip reserved for utilities, N. 2-00 E.
80 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots No. 10 and 11;
thence along the common line of said last mentioned lots, N. 88-0 W. 182.5
feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.
