until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Dunklin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 1.9 acres, more or less, bounded on the North by Beech Springs Road, East by Cooley Bridge Road, South and West by lands of Mitchell C. Moore, and old road being the line on the West. Said tract of land being more particularly described on a plat prepared by Dalton & Neves, Surveyors, dated July, 1946, as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on Cooley Bridge Road, the Northeast corner of this tract and running thence N. 55-30 W. 100 feet to a point; thence N. 59-15 W. 63 feet to Beech Springs Road; thence along Beech Springs Road S. 83-45 W. 188.5 feet to an old road; thence along the old road S. 5-07 E. 270.3 feet to a point; thence S. 88-49 E. 286.6 feet to Cooley Bridge Road; thence along Cooley Bridge Road N. 4-06 E. 210.9 feet to the point of beginning.
