## AFFIDAVIT

Personally appeared before me Evelyn Margaret Taft who, on oath, says: That she is the mortgagor who executed and delivered to William Elliott and Robert Gage as Receivers of Peoples State Bank of South Carolina that certain mortgage in the sum of \$250.00 dated on or about September 22, 1936, and recorded in the S. M. O. Office for Greenville County in Mortgage Book 118, page 605, that said mortgage has been paid in full and satisfied by the mortgagees, as evidenced by the attached real estate satisfaction, dated October 17, 1939; that the said mortgagees, at the time the attached satisfaction of mortgage was forwarded to me, also forwarded to me said note and mortgage marked satisfied, but that said note and mortgage have been lost or destroyed; that deponent has made diligent search for same but has been unable to find it, although she was fortunate enough to find the above Satisfaction; that deponent knows that said mortgage has not been assigned, hypothecated or otherwise disposed of, but that, as before stated, same has been lost or destroyed and after diligent search cannot be found.

Deponent is informed and believes that the above mentioned Receivers of the Peoples State Bank of South Carolina have been discharged as such and, therefore, the mortgagees, officially, do not any longer exist.
