"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of hand, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, on the Southern side of Windsor Drive, near the City of Greenville, being shown as lot # 12; on Plat of Northwoods Subdivision, made by Piedmont Engineering Service, on April 24th, 1947, recorded in Plat Book "P" at Page 123, and described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a stake on the Southern side of Windsor Drive, 360 feet West from Summitt Drive, at corner of lot # 10, and running thence with line of said lot, S. 1-18 W. 178.4 feet to a stake; thence N. 89-31 W. 70 feet to a stake at corner of lot # 14; thence with line of said lot, N. 1-18 E. 178.4 feet to a stake on Windsor Drive; thence with the Southern side of Windsor Drive, S. 89-32 E. 70 feet to the beginning corner.
