

AND IT IS AGREED, by and between the parties hereto, that the said parties shall and enjoy the said premises until the death of the said parties.

And if at any time any part of the said premises shall be sold, the rents and profits of the said premises shall be paid to the said parties, their Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, until the death of the said parties, who may at chambers or otherwise, appoint a receiver to receive the said rents and profits, applying the same to the payment of the interest, costs and expenses without delay, and the balance to the said parties, or the persons actually collected.
